



On delivery of an electric forklift from Westexe Forklifts it is the responsibility of the customer to have the charger wired in by a Qualified Mains Electrical Contractor. Unfortunately forklift engineers and lorry drivers do not have the required training, expertise or insurance to complete mains electrical works.

Sometimes the charger will be delivered with a cable attached and sometimes not, this is down to the electrical engineer that unwired the charger before collection from its last working environment. This should not significantly affect the cost of installation or time taken to do so.



Sometimes a charger will come with a single or 3 phase plug already attached that has been previously connected by a Qualified Mains Electrical Engineer.

On collection of an electric forklift from site it is also the responsibility of the customer to make sure the charger is disconnected from the mains power source by a Qualified Mains Electrical Contractor before transport arrives and that the forklift has a reasonable amount of charge to be manoeuvred onto the lorry.
